Re: Follow-Up BL11-14 DR2174 Power of Attorney for a Motor Vehicle (Secure POA) - Lien Release and Duplicate Titles

This bulletin is a follow-up to BL11-14 DR2174 Power of Attorney for a Motor Vehicle (Secure POA) - Lien Release and Duplicate Titles. In order to address concerns with the dates being pre-populated, we will accept the following:

The date (#2 in sample attached) that the person exercises the power of attorney must be the date when the title is physically received and reviewed by the agent. If this date is incorrect, a correction may be made by the person certifying they have reviewed the title by placing a single strike through the incorrect date, writing in the corrected date and completing a Statement of Fact indicating the error. Please see a sample DR 2174 below

As a reminder, the practice of auto populating the date of the person exercising power of attorney on the DR 2174 should be discontinued immediately.

- Colorado licensed motor vehicle dealers shall use this form when the title is physically held by a lienholder or the original title has been lost.
- This form may be used by an individual or entity to sign as both the buyer and seller to acknowledge the odometer reading.
- This form must be submitted with the title application documents.
- Federal and state law requires that you state the mileage in connection with the transfer of ownership.
- Failure to complete or providing a false statement may result in fines and/or imprisonment and may make you liable to your transferee pursuant to 49 U.S.C. 32709.
