Senate Bill 18-102 Odometer Reading Physical Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) Verification, effective August 8, 2018, removes the odometer reading requirement as part of the VIN verification.

The odometer field has been removed from the DR 2704 Colorado Certified VIN Inspection and the DR 2698 Verification of Vehicle Identification Number. Older versions of the DR 2698 that have the odometer field left blank will be accepted on and after August 8, 2018 for 90 days. This change does not impact the requirements for an odometer disclosure as part of any other titling process.
