Colorado Department of Revenue and Governor's Office of Information Technology Release Request for Proposals (RFP)

Colorado Driver License, Record, Indentification and Vehicle Enterprise Solution (Colorado DRIVES)

June 27, 2014 – Denver, CO. The Colorado Department of Revenue (CDOR) and Governor's Office of Information Technology (OIT) today released an RFP to replace the legacy systems Driver's License System (DLS) and Colorado State Titling and Registration System (CSTARS) currently used by the Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) and implement a modern customercentric commercial-off-the-shelf (COTS) integrated system.

CDOR and the OIT are seeking qualified Offerors who can provide a solution for replacement of the DLS, CSTARS and supporting systems that best achieves the business, operational and technical goals. The RFP process is being used to ensure an open and competitive bid process.
